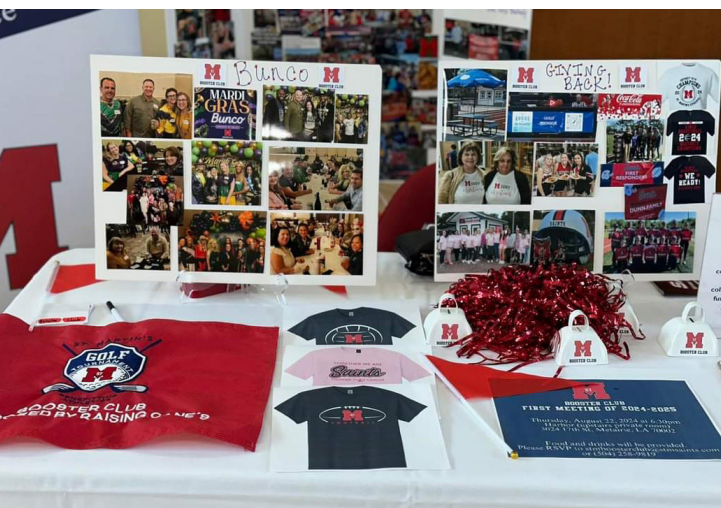
Booster Club Mission Statement:

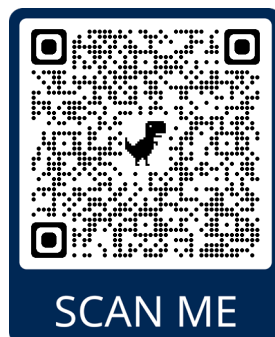

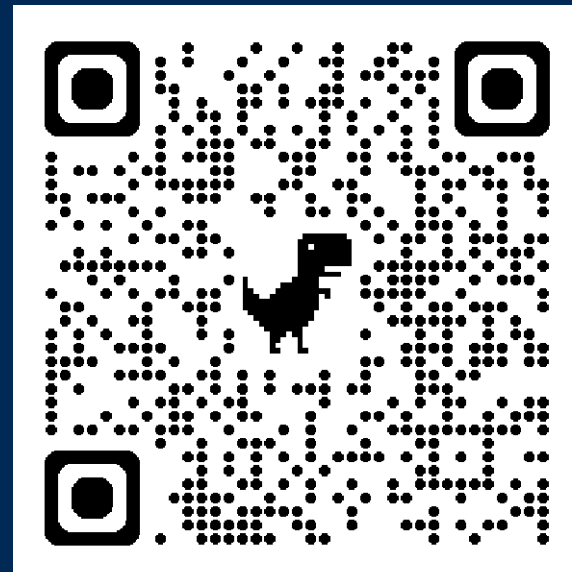
